

## How to prepare your home for a SilverFish Spray

**Important to know:** It is <u>required</u> for you to <u>remove all pets and cover fish tanks.</u> You must stay out of the unit during and after treatment for 4 hours. Persons with underlying health conditions should consult their family physician where they have concerns regarding re-entry time. Upon re-entry, please open windows for 20 min to properly ventilate the treated rooms.

## **Preparations Steps:**

Silverfish are drawn to moisture, like to appear in places that have a lot of humidity or moisture, places such as the bathroom, laundry room, or basement.

For treatment to be successful the following preparation must be completed prior to service. Sanitation is essential.

- 1. Remove all old or ripped shelf paper, reduce clutter as SilverFish feed on paper products and cardboard boxes.
- 2. They tend to hide in cluttered areas, especially near sources of heat and moisture. Therefore:
  - a. Move items away from walls, all items must be moved a minimum of six (6)inches away from walls throughout the entire home.
  - b. Empty all lower kitchen & bathroom cupboards

## **After Our Treatment Is Complete:**

1. Do not spray or remove the chemicals as the residual pesticide needs to remain intact for efficacy.
