



PRE-TREATMENT PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

A licensed exterminator will be performing pest control services in your home and it is necessary that the following preparation be completed before your scheduled treatment. You will need to stay out of your home for **4 Hours** after the exterminator arrives (or as otherwise indicated).

PETS

- ❗ **TREAT PETS FOR FLEAS:** Your pets must be treated for fleas by your vet prior to the treatment of your home. You may be required to provide proof to your building management that your pets have been treated.
- ❗ **REMOVE ALL PETS FROM YOUR HOME.** Fish tanks may be left in home but must be covered and filters disconnected.

FLOORS & FURNITURE

1. Remove all personal belongings, clothes and clutter from floors.
2. Vacuum floors, carpets and rugs extensively, including under and around furniture and along all baseboards. Thoroughly rinse the vacuum canister and discard of any vacuum bags outside of the building immediately after use.
3. Move all furniture (including tables, nightstands, dressers, TV stands and bookshelves) at least one foot away from walls and baseboards.

POST-TREATMENT INFORMATION

- ❗ Do not re-enter your home for **4 Hours** after the treatment (or as otherwise indicated).

HEALTH CONCERNS

If you have any health issues, respiratory problems or you are pregnant or have a newborn baby, it may be advisable to stay out longer. Please consult your doctor.

CLEANING

Do not use any cleaning solutions within one foot of the baseboards for approximately 3 weeks to reduce interference with treatment.

INCREASED PEST ACTIVITY

Do not be alarmed if you notice increased pest activity for 1 week after the treatment. This is normal and it is the result of the treatment.
