



### PRE-TREATMENT PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

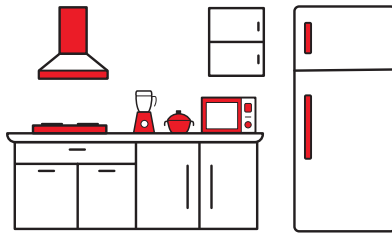
A licensed exterminator will be performing pest control services in your home and it is necessary that the following preparation be completed before your scheduled treatment. You will need to stay out of your home for **4 Hours** after the treatment (or as otherwise indicated).

#### KITCHEN

1. Remove all food, dishes and personal belongings from top and bottom kitchen cabinets and cupboards and leave open.
2. Place kitchen items in the center of the dining room and cover with garbage bags.
3. Clear countertops and area on top of cupboards and fridge. Ensure kitchen is completely empty.

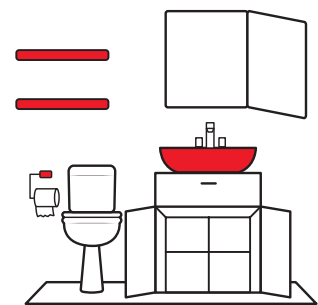
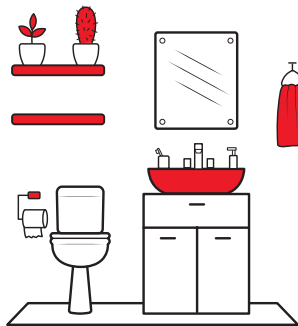


#### BATHROOM

1. Remove all hygiene products, medication and toiletries. Place into plastic bags and seal tightly.
2. Place all bagged items in the bathtub.
3. Ensure all medicine cabinets, drawers and cupboards under the sink are completely empty.

#### INCREASED PEST ACTIVITY

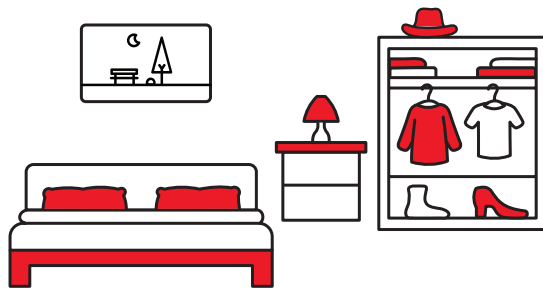
Do not be alarmed if you notice increased pest activity for 7 to 14 days after the treatment. This is normal and it is the result of the treatment.



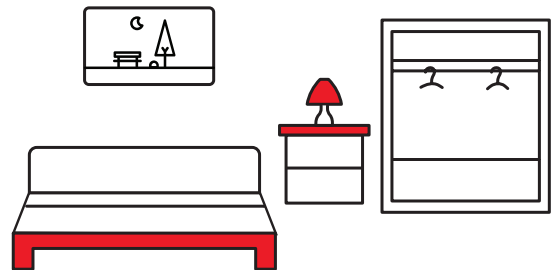
### BEDROOM

1. Empty everything from closets, including clothing on shelves and on hangers.
2. Remove all bedding, including blankets, sheets, pillowcases and bed skirts.
3. Remove contents from inside and on top of dressers and nightstands. Place contents in center of room in an open container.
4. Suitcases must be emptied and left open in center of room for treatment.
