PRE-TREATMENT PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

A licensed exterminator will be performing pest control services in your home and it is necessary that the following preparation be completed before your scheduled treatment. You do not need to stay out of your home during or after the treatment.

KITCHEN

1. We will need access to all lower kitchen cupboards, mainly underneath the sink.
2. Please pull out your fridge and stove from the wall.
3. Please clean inside lower cupboards and behind fridge and stove to help with mice treatment.

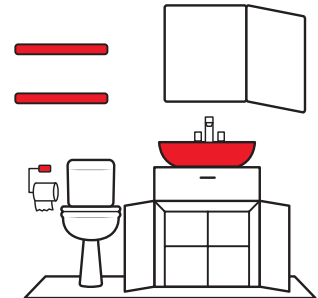
BATHROOM

POST-TREATMENT INFORMATION

- ✓ You may re-enter your home immediately after treatment.

DO NOT TAMPER

Do not tamper with the baited areas or apply any additional pest control products or cleaning solution as this will eliminate the effectiveness of the treatment.

CLEANING

Ensure to keep your home clean by removing any crumbs, grease and other food products in and around the kitchen and appliances to eliminate competing food sources.

INCREASED PEST ACTIVITY

Do not be alarmed if you notice increased pest activity for 7 to 14 days after the treatment. This is normal and it is the result of the treatment.
