



How to prepare your home for a Carpenter Ant Treatment

It is necessary for you to remove all pets, cover fish tanks and remain out of the unit for approximately 4 – 6 hours following the treatment. If you have any respiratory or other medical issues it is recommended that you stay out of the unit for 24 hours.

To help resolve a carpenter ant infestation in your home it is necessary to follow these guidelines:

Before treatment:

How to prepare your home prior to technician arriving:

1. Empty all lower kitchen & washroom cupboards (if ants are seen in upper cupboards please empty as well)
2. Move items/furniture 12” (30cm) away from the walls (Please be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move very large/heavy items/furniture) we will do our best to work around the areas.
3. Access to closet flooring area around tracks and baseboards
4. Access to all window frames
5. Vacuum and clean all areas before treatment, wash all garbage bins with hot soapy water regularly.

During Treatment:

Carpenter ants typically infest areas where moisture is an issue such as areas around dishwashers or wood that is water damaged. To solve a carpenter ant infestation, it is important to locate and treat the nest area and resolve the moisture issues. A general baseboard treatment will be done to help control any foraging ants. Insecticide sprays, dusts and / or ant bait may be used.

Post Treatment Information:

- 1. Following the treatment, any baits that were used must be left where the technician has placed them.**
- 2. Do not wash the baseboard areas for at least 3 week after the treatment.**
- 3. DO NOT spray any insecticides or use cleaning chemicals on or near the bait**
