

## How to prepare your home for a Common Insect Spray

**Important to know:** It is <u>required</u> for you to <u>remove all pets and cover fish tanks.</u> You must stay out of the unit during and after treatment for 4 hours. Persons with underlying health conditions should consult their family physician where they have concerns regarding re-entry time. Upon re-entry, please open windows for 20 min to properly ventilate the treated rooms.

## **Preparations Steps:**

For treatment to be successful the following preparation must be completed prior to service. Sanitation is essential.

- 1. Clean kitchen thoroughly, including floor, stove and counter tops.
- 2. Pull out refrigerator, stove, etc. and clean behind and underneath. All cleaning
- 3. should be done before, not after treatment.
- 4. Everything should be removed from Lower Kitchen & Washroom cupboards
- 5. Clear along baseboards and window frames

## **After Our Treatment Is Complete:**

- 1. Thoroughly wash (with soap and water) all exposed eating surfaces (including table and
- 2. counter tops) and any exposed dishes or silverware.
- 3. Do not leave empty milk or beverage bottles inside.
- 4. Keep areas under and behind stoves and refrigerators clean.
- 5. Do not allow food and garbage to
- 6. accumulate in areas where pest feed or hide.
- 6. Pet food should be stored in sealed containers.
